And of course there are side tables available to match the upholstered furniture. 

The square or rectangle side tables have the same type of frame. With laminate or wood-veneered finishes they can be perfectly matched with the functions and design concepts they are required for.





Top materials and careful craftsmanship guarantee durability and quality. Solid wood, beech frames that are covered and upholstered, and multi-layer upholstery with fibre fleece overlay, as well as first-class covers, combine a pleasant feeling when you sit on the chair with constant comfort. The side tables are exceptional for their characteristic oval profiles and solid panels made of birch plywood.
